**Re:** Dissolution of the Project LEARN Committee

On Thursday, May 13, 2021, current members of Project LEARN—Robert Holcomb, Josh Adams, and Rachael Cutcher—met with Academic Senate President Julie Thompson to discuss the current status and future direction of the Project LEARN Committee.

The meeting was scheduled after a similar discussion had taken place among VPAA Jane Saldaña-Talley, Julie Thompson, and Robert Holcomb on Friday, April 23, 2021.

In both meeting discussions, it was noted that Project LEARN has not operated as an active Committee for the past several years and that recent attempts to assert a meaningful role among faculty has not gained momentum.

In preparation for SRJC's upcoming Accreditation Self-Study process, there is consensus that a more practical and straightforward approach toward SLOs needs to be implemented and that Project LEARN does not provide a viable structure or mechanism toward that end.

As such, it is our recommendation that the Project LEARN Committee become dissolved to make way for newer and more direct strategies toward SLO work.
